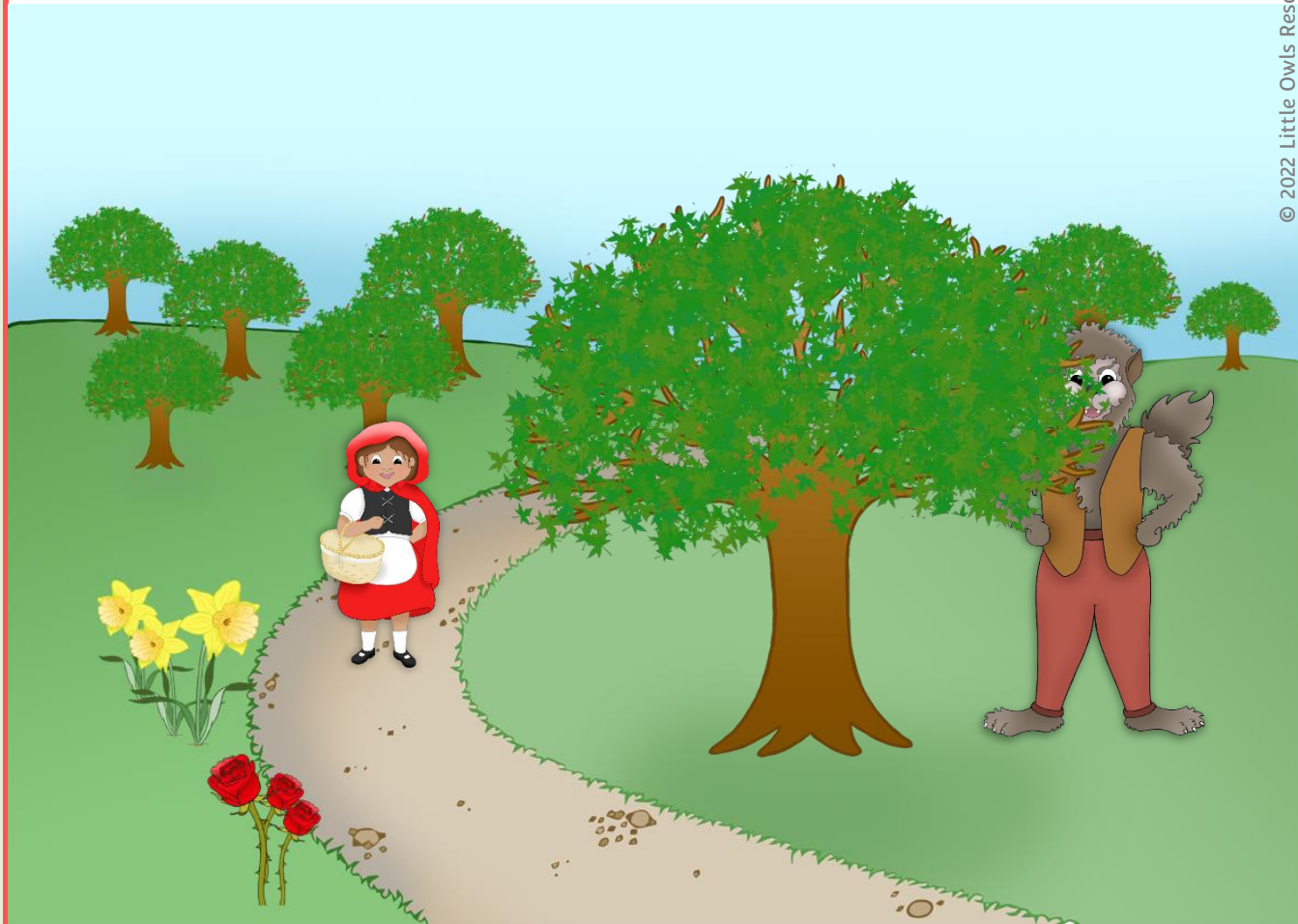


There was once a girl called Little Red Riding Hood. One day she asked her mother if she could visit her grandma in the forest.

A wolf appeared beside Little Red Riding Hood. “Where are you walking to?” he asked.

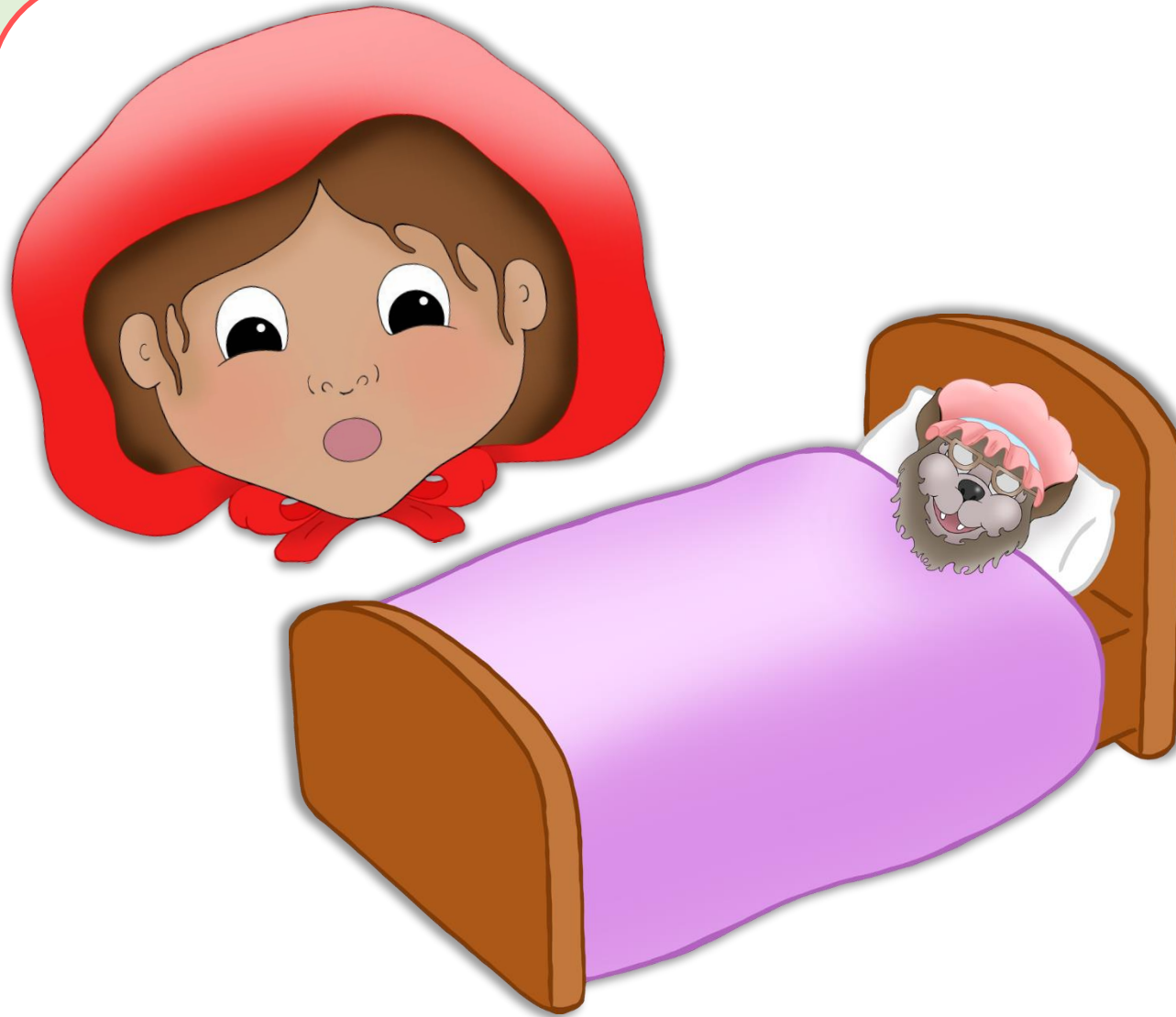
“I am going to my grandma’s cottage in the forest.” She replied.



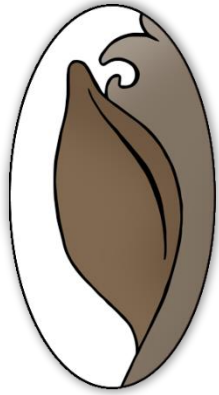

At grandma's cottage, Little Red Riding Hood noticed that grandma looked a bit different.



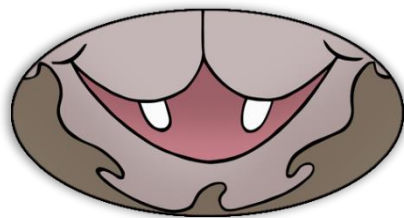
“Grandma, what big **ears** you have!”

*“All the better to **see** you with my dear!”*



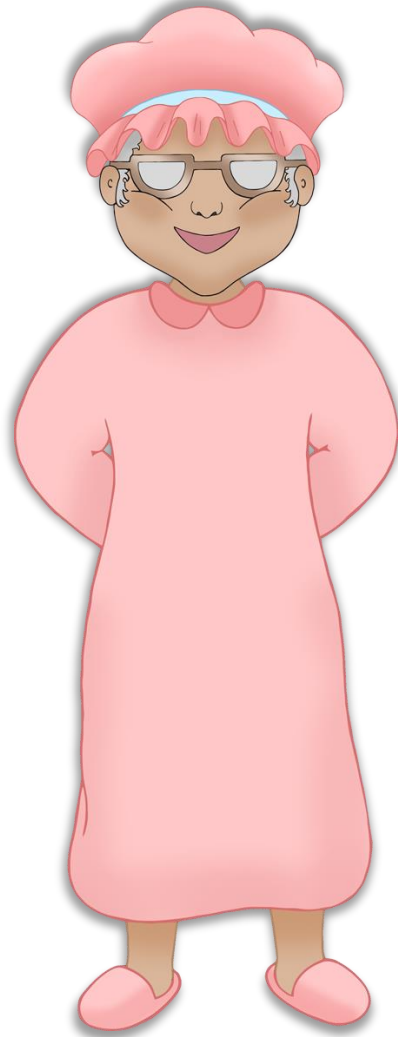
“Grandma, what big **teeth** you have!”
