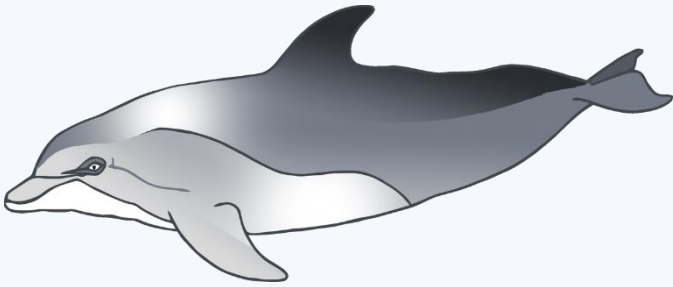


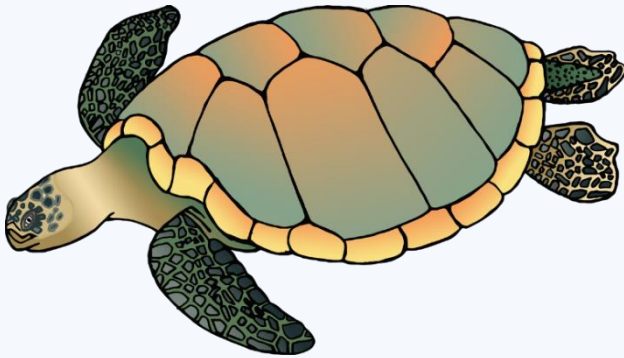
## Bottlenose Dolphin

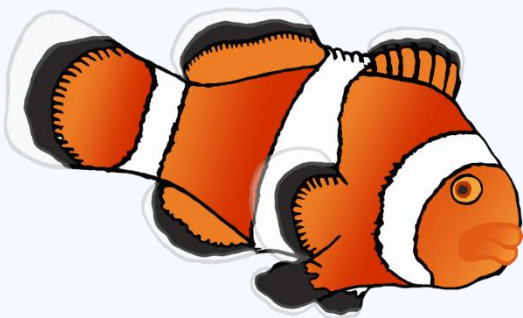
## Sea Turtle

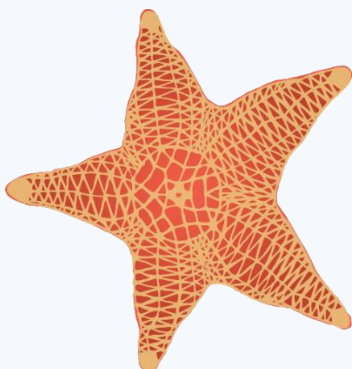
## Yellow Seahorse

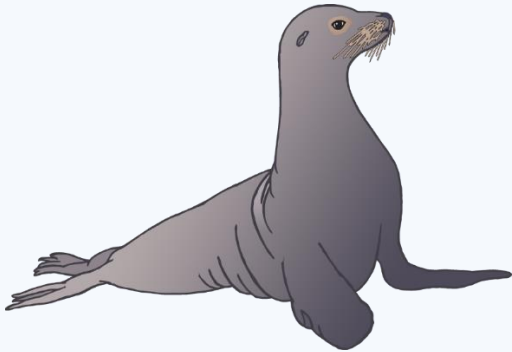
## Common Starfish

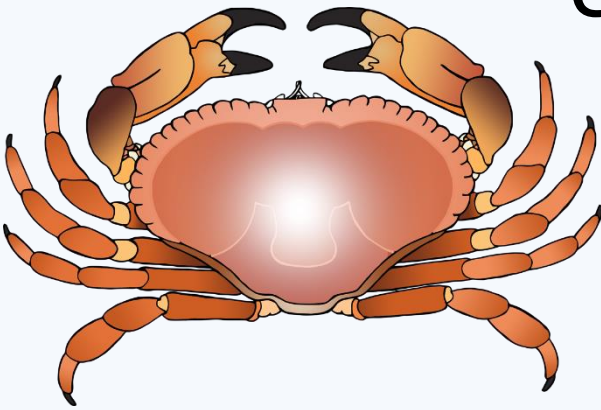
## California Sea Lion

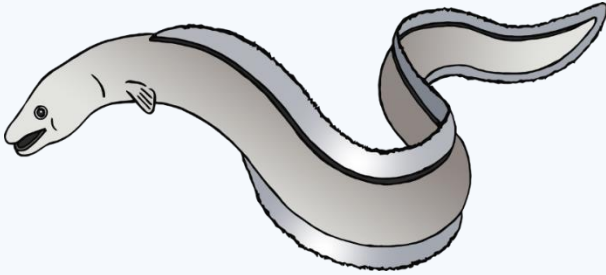
## Sea Nettle Jellyfish

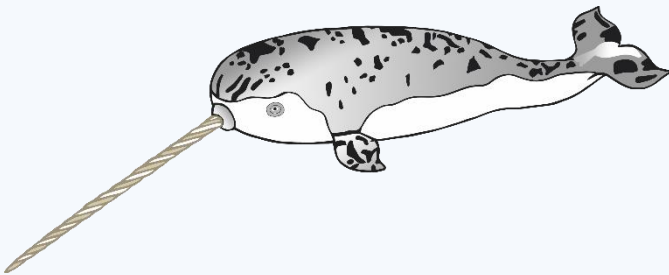
## Conger Eel
